Presentation and discussion related to placemaking.

BACKGROUND:

In preparation for the Planning and Zoning Commission's upcoming retreat on Saturday, November 3, 2018, staff will be making a presentation to the Commission related to placemaking. Placemaking is the process of creating quality places where people want to live, work, play, shop, learn, and visit.

The presentation will address the following items:
